What this is

One America, One Letter is an independent, student-built project inviting people to choose dignity, honesty, and human connection—even when disagreement remains. The goal is not to win an argument. It is to remember the person on the other side and make one relationship more human.

Now it is your turn

1	Visit OneAmericaOneLetter.org. See the movement, read examples, and learn how one physical letter can begin repairing distance.
2	Take the pledge with your email. This records your participation in the shared count. Your email stays private and is never displayed publicly.
3	Choose a free tool. Download printable postcards, a letter starter, sample letters, and other guidance to make beginning easier.
4	Send one honest physical letter or postcard. Include this page—or one of the optional mini cards—so the next person knows how to join and pass it forward.
